North Area Community Policing News - PS Crawford Laing

June saw the continuation of festivals across the Scottish Borders and this is particularly busy time for officers on the Community Teams as they are the first port of call for Policing these events. Whilst I have worked in the Borders on and off for around ten years now, I have had very little involvement in these events until this summer. For me, this is one of the benefits of working in a Community role within the Police. It is great to see the passion within our communities when it comes to Common Ridings, Local Festivals and other events.

Unfortunately, criminals continue to operate through the summer months and I would encourage all in our communities to keep up their guard in relation to security. We are more likely to leave windows and doors open in an effort to cool our homes. Also, bikes, motorbikes and sports equipment are more frequently used and may be left more visible around our homes, gardens and attached to cars. This can provide additional opportunity for thieves.

Protecting most vulnerable



In June 2025 Police in the Scottish Borders attended and were involved with 193 mental health related calls, 33 missing person enquiries and 95 domestic related incidents.

Tweeddale East and West had 15 mental health related calls 6 missing person enquiries. Due to GDPR and protection of victims/subjects involved, we are unable to share any more specific information in relation to these type of call within this report.

Police Scotland work in collaboration with key partners to assist the most vulnerable within the communities and to provide support.



Reducing Violence and Anti-Social Behaviour

The Scottish Borders CID Proactive Unit executed 12 Drug & General Evidence Warrants during the month of June which resulted in the seizures of quantities of Class A/B controlled drugs and over £20,000 cash from the various addresses.
